**Subject:** Reporting

I'm going to be receiving a Microsoft Access database that contains all of our targets pre-loaded in it. I have to send the report in once a day no later than 1600. For each specific arrest, in addition to the a-number, name, dob and citizenship, I have to report the zip code of the arrest. I'm not sure if the address has to be reported too, but I do remember the part about the zip code of the arrest being an important piece of information to capture.

I'm sure it has filtered down to everyone, but as of right now, they only want targets arrested unless you come across a collateral that is a **confirmed convicted criminal alien**. They went as far as to say, like [REDACTED] wrote in his summation of the last conference call, that **if you see your target, you should arrest your target and leave the scene w/o anyone else being interviewed**. I'm not sure what else to say about that, but **I will not be able to enter any information in the database if it relates to a non-convicted, non-criminal alien**.

Also, I have asked [REDACTED] to see if we are supposed to input these arrests in FCMS like we did last summer. I haven't heard anything back though. I also asked to see if we are supposed to have non FUGOPS assigned officers change their Enforce splash screen assignment to FUGOPS, for processing, like last summer's operation as well. I'm waiting for a response back from that too.

Getting back to the reporting, if you can fax all of the 213s to me by 1500, I should have enough time to input them in the database and send off the attachment to the FOSC by 1600. Anything after 1600 will go on the next day, except for the last day. The fax number to use is [REDACTED].
