I spoke to [REDACTED] at HQ this morning about the FCMS entry and the FUGOPS/ENFORCE splash screen stuff I wrote about yesterday.

She said, "yes" we will be inputting all arrests in FCMS with dropdown of Operation Crosscheck selected.

She also said that all processed aliens for this operation should be processed as a FUGOPS arrest, so the splash screen in ENFORCE for non FUGOPS team members should be changed prior to processing. If for some reason the person is processed and the FUGOPS assignment is not selected, there is still an Operation Crosscheck dropdown to be selected on the first page of the initial event.
